Contest Rules

1. No entry fee is required.
2. Only fourth-grade students are eligible to enter. This contest is not open to additional grade levels at this time.
3. Entries must be submitted by a teacher or member of school staff. Individual entries submitted by parents are not eligible at this time.
4. All essays must adhere to the prompt. Essays are judged primarily for content, not grammar or spelling.
5. Entries must be the original work of the student. Each entry should be produced by an individual student and should not be the product of collaboration among multiple students.
6. Entries are not required to include a student's last name. First name and last initial are acceptable.
7. Stories can be more than one page but should not exceed five pages in length. Entries with multiple pages should be stapled.
8. Judging is conducted anonymously. All decisions by the panel of judges are final.
9. All entries must be postmarked Monday, February 29, to be eligible. Winners will be announced Tuesday, March 15. Teachers of winning students will be contacted on that date.
